Glowforge:

Outside materials used in the Glowforge must be inspected and approved by staff. We strongly recommend purchasing pre-vetted materials for the Glowforge. Glowforge materials can be up to 2 inches tall without the crumb tray or up to .5 inches tall with the crumb tray.

Forbidden materials:

Chrome tanned leather

Vinyl

Anything containing PVC

Any highly reflective metals except anodized aluminum

Materials for purchase:

Draft Board (proofgrade draftboard fully masked)– \$10/board

MDF Board (medium density fiberboard unmasked)– \$6/board

Acrylic Sheets (5x10)-- \$7/sheet 8x8/ -\$4.25

3D Printer:

The 3D Printer uses PLA filament only. Filament must be purchased from the library

PLA filament– \$0.50 for up to 10 grams, then \$0.05/gram

Projects will be weighed upon completion

Pottery:

The pottery wheel is for water based clays only. Patrons may not throw polymer clay. Any type/brand of air dry clay is welcome, though we recommend Crayola. Clays that require firing must be purchased from the library, and are purchased from the Artist Exchange and compatible with their kiln. If you wish to glaze your piece, you will need two total firings, one before glazing, and one after.

Air Dry Clay– \$2/pound

White Low Fire Clay-Earthenware– \$1/pound

Red Low Fire Clay-Earthenware– \$1/pound

Food Safe Glaze (per piece)-- \$2/piece

Firing at the Artist's Exchange:

Single small item that fits in a 6x6 cube \$5

Half round kiln shelf with objects under 6 inches tall \$10
Half round tall kiln shelf with object 6 inches or taller \$20
Full kiln firing \$70

Embroidery Machine:

Embroidery Thread per 6 square inch project– \$1

Buttons: \$0.05 each

Cricut:

Sticker Paper– \$1/sheet

Vinyl– \$0.75/sheet
